Containers should not be placed in	or around campsites and picnic shelters.		
Containers may not be placed in or on buildings or structures(i.e. signs, shelters, tables, play structures), in sensitive archaeological, historical, or ecological areas such as historic buildings, caves, glades, landscaped planting beds, or locations that contain rare plant species. No digging or disruption of soil or rock walls is permitted when placing a container.			
Containers may not be placed in locations that could potentially endanger those searching for them, e.g., on cliffs or bluffs, in or near bodies of water, or in areas prone to frequent flooding. No Extreme Caches. Caches with difficulty rating 4 or above will not be permitted.			
Permittee accepts the possibility that a container may be stolen, damaged or destroyed by other area users, or as a result of common natural resource management activities, such as prescribed burns.			
In the event that the container is missing or removed, the permittee must notify the parks department so that this permit can be cancelled and update the status of the cache/box on the above listed website(s).			
Permittee accepts that the area manager may remove the container if it becomes unsightly, the surrounding natural resources are adversely affected, or the container contains items that are not family-friendly.
